

Fibres  Exotica

Gone Fishin'

Difficulty:

A Breeze

Materials:

35g (Under 1 skein) Fibres Exotica Filament (100% Reeled Mulberry Silk ; c.900m per 100g)

Crochet Hook – size 2mm/UK 14/US B-1 (or size needed to obtain gauge)

Knitter's needle

Scissors

Sizes:

One Size.

This is a “not very complex at all” pattern for a fishing net shawl. I think the simplicity of the pattern lets the silk and its lovely colours shine through, and makes it wearable year round.

Abbreviations (UK terms):

ST(S) : stitch(es)
CH(S) : chain(s)
DC : double crochet
HTR : half treble
TR : treble
DTR : double treble

Directions:

Chain 368

Row 1: Skip 7, DC in next ch, *ch5 skip 3ch DC in next ch* to end

Row 2: Ch2 DC in 5 ch *5tr in DC, DC in 5ch* until last DC, 5tr in DC, DC in ch, turn

Row 3: Sk first tr, DC in next tr *10ch DC in 5ch from Row 2, on left side of DC from previous row, then DC in 5ch on right side of DC from previous row* 10ch, DC left of DC from previous row, turn

Row 4: 10ch, DC in 10ch *10ch DC in next 10ch* 10 ch DC in ch beside 5 tr from row 2, turn

Row 5: 1ch 5DC in ch, 2ch, *DC in 10ch, 2ch, 4DTR in DC, 2 ch, DC in 10ch, 2 ch* until last, 4DTR in last DC, 2ch, 1DC in 10ch, turn

Row 6: 1ch, DC in 2ch, DC in each DTR, DC in 2ch, DC in DC, *10ch, DC in DC* last DC in DC left of last 4 DTR

Row 7-23: 1 ch, 5DC into 10ch *10ch, DC in middle of 10ch* to end (as rows are worked the wrap will slowly decrease)

Row 24: 1 ch *3DC, 3htr, 5tr, 3htr, 3DC in 10ch, DC in DC* until end, forming each shell as it is made.
