

# Fibres Exotica

## W wave

**Difficulty:**

Some Thought Required

**Materials:**

200g (2 Skeins) Fibres Exotica Duke Fine (100% Mulberry Silk ; 320m per 100g skein)

Straight Knitting needles 4mm/UK 8/US 6 (or size needed to obtain gauge)

Knitter's needle

Scissors

**Gauge:**

**Sizes:**

One Size.

The wave pattern section is a repeat over 16st, so the shawl can be made either wider or narrower as desired by either added or removing one or more of the central pattern repeat sections.

**Abbreviations:**

K:	Knit
P:	Purl
St(s):	Stitch(es)
St st:	Stocking Stitch
Rpt:	Repeat
k2tog tbl:	Knit 2 stitches together through the back loop of the stitch (Decrease stitch)
kfb:	Knit into both the Front and Back of the same stitch (Increase stitch)

**Directions:**

CO 72 st

Row 1-4: st st.

Start the wave:

Row 5: k2tog tbl 4 times, \*kfb 8 times, k2tog tbl 8 times; rpt from \* to last 8st, k2tog tbl 4 times

Row 6: P all sts

Row 7: K all sts

Row 8: P all sts

Rpt wave section until shawl is required length (or there is just enough yarn left to work last 4 rows)

Last 4 rows: st st.
